Within the framework of the course "International Social Work: global issues in migrations and development," which is taught by Professor **Roberta Di Rosa** and designed as part of the Master's Degree in Cooperation, Development, and Migrations (LM-81) at the **University of Palermo**, a series of seminars open to the public will be held, which can be attended both in person and online.

A series of seminars that will become a fundamental platform for the exchange of ideas and the generation of innovative solutions to current challenges in the field of **migration**.

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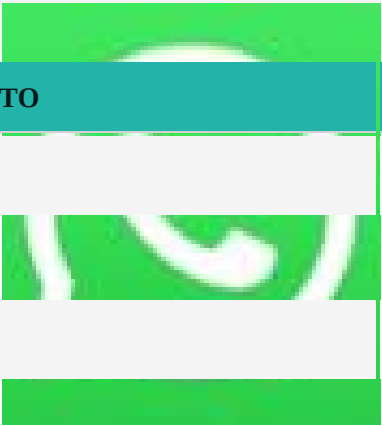
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
